



Consignment Agreement

This agreement is a brief outline of what we do for our artists and what we expect from you.

To pick up or drop off artwork, you must schedule an appointment.

Please provide a written list of the pieces and suggested prices. Retail prices will be determined in consultation between the owners and the artist and should be in line with prices charged elsewhere—at shows, on Etsy, or on the artist's website.

The artist will receive 50% of the agreed retail price for items that are sold in the shop. If a customer contacts the artist directly after seeing the artist's work at A Show of Hands, we will collect a commission or finder's fee of at least 15%.

Pieces may be labeled with a logo, but may NOT show a website, phone number, or other contact information, except in the case of pre-printed greeting cards. All earrings must be supplied on cards. Earring wires must be sterling silver or gold filled.

Artwork will be at the shop for at least three months. How and where artwork is displayed is at the discretion of the shop's owners.

At the end of three months, artists must contact the shop to arrange a pickup. Some items may be displayed for longer than three months, but frequent rotation is encouraged to keep the inventory fresh and current. There is no storage space at the shop so items that the shop owners do not choose to display for additional time should be picked up by the end of the fourth month. Otherwise, they will be donated to local charities for silent auctions or other fundraisers.

All artwork is owned by the artist while in the shop and should be insured by the artist. The artist will be responsible for ensuring that all items arrive undamaged and ready to display.

Checks are processed between the 15th and 25th of every month. Artists are asked not call to ask about their check. Checks are only mailed if the balance is over \$20.

The shop owners reserve the right to terminate any artists participation at A Show of Hands for any reason, including the following: providing direct contact information to customers, failing to make an appointment to drop off or pick up work, leaving work in the shop for more than three months, copyright infringement, consigning work made by someone else.
